

### Disaster response

featuring features a light and medium field hospitals, in line with WHO Emergency Medical Teams (EMT) guidelines:

1. Type 1 EMT - light, rapid response, field medical post that can operate in rugged terrain for two weeks and is staffed by 16 staff;
2. Type 2 EMT - 20-bed field hospital with a two-week self sufficiency and staffed by 30 staff (no surgical and x-ray capacity yet).

Deployment time: 24 hours.

PCPM EMT was deployed to **Nepal** in wake of the 2015 Earthquake.

### Humanitarian Aid

focusing primarily on refugees and internally displaced, as well as on immediate post-conflict stabilization and reconstruction:

1. **Emergency shelter** in camp, non-camp and urban settings - PCPM specializes in securing refugees' shelter through cash-based rental support (Cash for Rent in **Lebanon** and **Ukraine**), improvement of living conditions in the refugee camps (**Arsal, Lebanon**) and improvement of living conditions in urban settings (**Beirut, Lebanon**).
2. **Temporary shelter.** PCPM rebuilt two villages in **Nepal** with temporary shelters after the 2015 earthquake and provided 500 IKEA Houses for IDP camps and refugees in region of Mosul, **Iraq**.
3. **Cash assistance** – PCPM provides:
  - a) Conditional cash assistance for:
    - payment of rent for an apartment / other shelter (Cash for Rent in **Lebanon** and **Ukraine**),
    - winter-related purchase of fuel and clothing (Cash for Winterization).
  - b) Unconditional Cash Assistance programs in line with country-specific cash assistance criteria (**Lebanon**).
4. **Public works and employment** - PCPM supports transition of affected persons away from humanitarian aid through public works and Cash for Work programs (**Lebanon, Ukraine**)
5. **Social services, including health and education.** Since 2014, PCPM operates a health and education center for Syrian refugees in **Lebanon**.
6. **Rehabilitation of public services:** PCPM rehabilitated schools in IDP-hosting regions of eastern **Ukraine** and clinics in Bidi Bidi refugee camp in **Uganda**, the latter together with improved staff accommodation.

### Development Aid

focuses on thematic areas that facilitate economic growth and job creation in Africa and Middle East:

1. **Disaster risk reduction and capacity building of emergency services.** Since 2014, thanks to Polish Aid funding, PCPM has implemented largest fire brigade training program in **Kenya** that benefited over 40% of Kenya's firefighters and facilitated establishment of fire-rescue services in several counties. PCPM is currently establishing a fire brigade academy, housed in the outskirts of Nairobi, that will train firefighters and rescue personnel from Kenya and other countries of Eastern Africa. In 2018, PCPM plans to produce first Kenya-manufactured fire truck that could be a role model rescue vehicle for Eastern Africa. PCPM-implemented fire brigade and ambulance training programs were also implemented in eight cities of **Ethiopia**, in **South Sudan** and **Lebanon**. In **Georgia**, PCPM trained local governments in disaster management and installed flood early warning systems.
2. **Solar and hydro power.** PCPM has provided solar lighting to over 500 rural schools (300,000 children) in southern **Ethiopia** and developed designs for several small- and medium-size solar power plants and electricity grids. PCPM is currently preparing construction of a water dam in **Uganda's** Bidi Bidi refugee camp.
3. **Social / affordable housing.** In coordination with the World Bank, PCPM is implementing Polish Government-funded social housing project in **Burkina Faso** that addresses acute shortage of houses for the poorest families, as well as provides on-job masonry training. Low-cost construction of houses, schools and granaries are an important element of addressing root causes of migratory movements and may be expanded to **Niger** and **Mali**.
4. **Support to agriculture and cooperatives** in **Lebanon, Palestine** and **Kenya**. PCPM focuses on improved processing and marketing to increase value added of agriculture production and farmers incomes. PCPM facilitates exportation of food products from **Palestine** and **Lebanon** to the EU market. In **Palestine** we pilot new water saving technologies, including improved treatment of sewage.
5. **Industrial zones.** PCPM is partnering with UNDP and other UN Agencies in **Kenya** in an upcoming project that will see construction of several small- and medium industrial zones that will primarily benefit local Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs). The greenfield development would include industrial plots, water and sewage network, road access, as well as a fire station and primary social services (health, education).
