

## Refugee Camps / Temporary Shelters in Yemen / Syria

**Theme: Shelter / refugees**

**Country: Yemen and/or Syria**

Timeline: 6 months to 1 year

**Key objectives:**

- Improved, more dignified living conditions in refugee / IDP camps
- Temporary houses that can withstand heavy rain and wind, much more durable than tents (lifespan up to 5 years)
- Limited risk of fires in IDP camps
- IDPs / refugees obtain semblance of a home

**Key activities:**

- Delivery of improved shelter solution for IDP and refugee camps.

Refugee Shelter Unit (RHU) is:

- Durable - lifespan of 3 to 5 years
- Waterproof
- Floor space adequate for 5 persons (17.5m<sup>2</sup>)
- Easy to transport (40-foot container takes 36+ RHUs)
- Installation on the ground or on a concrete slab.
- RHUs can be used for temporary schools and clinics
- Installation takes between 4 and 8 hours

**Related PCPM activities:**

Between 2018 and 2020 PCPM provided over 1,250 Refugee Housing Units (RHUs) to:

- 500 RHUs to Iraq - return of IDPs to Mosul
- 300 RHUs to Jordan (Za'atari and Azraq camps)
- 200 RHUs to Syria (vicinity of Damascus and NE Syria)
- 156 RHUs to Greece - camps in Lesbos Island
- 100 RHUs to Uganda - setting up temporary health centers in Bidi Bidi Refugee Camps (NW Uganda)
